Dear Prospective Volunteer,

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at Fort HealthCare. We are always looking for more volunteers!

I am enclosing some information about our services for you to read over, and also an application. If you decide you would like to volunteer for Fort HealthCare, please complete the application and mail it back to me in the enclosed postpaid envelope. As soon as I get your application back, I will give you a call to set up an appointment for your interview and orientation. This appointment will take about one hour.

Please be aware that we do require a 50-hour (annual) commitment, and a health screening. The health screening includes a two-step TB skin test, flu vaccine (if you have not already received one for the season), blood titers to test for your immunity to measles, mumps, rubella and varicella, and possibly vaccinations if the blood work shows that they are needed. (There is no charge to you for the tests or vaccinations.) In addition, (per the state of Wisconsin) a criminal background check must be completed on all health care employees and volunteers.

Our volunteers find their work here to be fun, challenging and personally satisfying. I look forward to meeting you and getting you started as a volunteer in our health care system. Please feel free to give me a call at 920-568-5276 if you have any questions about the enclosed materials.
